



To the Class of 2021,

Congratulations! We are so close to the end of your journey here at Franklin Central High School. While this past year has been unusual to say the least, we are working tirelessly to ensure that the end of your academic career is successful and momentous. As the school year winds down to a close, there are some important pieces of information, with dates and times, to which you and your family will need to pay special attention. Below is a brief summary of important end of year information for all graduating seniors. **This includes cap/gowns/announcement pick up, commencement, and senior send-off/prom information.**

Cap and gown and announcement pick up- April 23rd

Cap and gown pick up for seniors will occur Friday, April 23, 2021 between 9:00 am and 3:00 pm in the Main Gym at Franklin Central High School. Pick up times: **Cohort #1 (A-K): 9a - 11a, Cohort #2: 12p -2p Virtual: 2p-3p.** All students should enter via door 8W. ***To avoid overcrowding and ease distribution, please make every effort to arrive during your designated window of time.***

Graduation Practice- May 28th

Seniors will be **REQUIRED** to attend Graduation Practice on Friday, May 28, at Franklin Central High School. ***Cohort 1 (Last names A-K) will be required to be at the school in the Main Gym at 8:00 am*** and should expect to finish no later than 9:30 am. ***Cohort 2 (Last names L-Z) will be required to be at the school in the Main Gym at 10:00 am*** and should expect to finish no later than 11:30 am. During this time, the seniors will be assigned their seats in the staging area and on the field; they will receive specific instructions as we rehearse what the ceremony will look like. No cap and gown or formal attire is required for practice. Please note that buses will not be running on this day. **Graduation tickets (4 per graduate) will be distributed at practice. *If you miss practice you will be scratched from the ceremony.*** Due to COVID-19 restrictions, there will not be additional tickets available.

Commencement- June 1st

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, **Commencement will be occurring in two separate ceremonies, both of which will take place at Flashes Stadium on June 1, 2021.** June 2, 2021 will serve as the rain date, if needed. **Each graduate will receive four tickets for the ceremony; however, the event will be livestreamed for family and/or friends that cannot attend in-person.** Students should plan on wearing business attire beneath their cap and gown. Because the ceremony will be taking place on our turf field, no heels or pumps will be allowed to be worn. Please assist us in keeping the stadium in top condition by wearing flats or something similar for your graduation walk.

- **The ceremony for Cohort 1 (Last names A-K) will begin promptly at 10:00 am; students are required to be at the Main Gym (where they went for practice) at 9:00 am.** Gates will open at 9:15 am, and the ceremony should conclude just after 11:00 am.
- **The ceremony for Cohort 2 (Last names L-Z) will begin promptly at 2:00 pm; students are required to be at the Main Gym (where they went for practice) at 1:00 pm.** Gates will open at 1:15 pm, and the ceremony should conclude just after 3:00 pm.
